

RULES

- 1. Hunters must comply with the NZ POLICE Fire Arms Code
- 2. No barrows - PIGS OVER 25KG ONLY.
- 3. Pigs under 25kg will not be accepted for weighing, but are eligible for tusk prizes.
- 4. One hunter per entry. Maximum x 1 animal per category (i.e. chamois, tahr Stags, Hinds).
- 5. maximum 3 pigs can be entered per entrant (i.e 1 boar for heaviest 1 boar for average & 1 sow)
- 6. All animals must be caught on or between, Friday 2nd and Sunday 4th June 2023.
- 7. All animals must be presented CLEAN GUTTED WITH NUTS IN. ALL GUTS TO BE REMOVED INCLUDING THROATS, ARSE HOLES AND PIZZELS. Failure to do so can result in the animal being refused. ! No excuses!
- 7.KIDS SPECIES only ONE weigh per species - to be whole and presented by the entrant.
- 8.. Animals of equal weight - first weighed is the winner. WEIGH IN CLOSES AT 2PM SHARP, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 9. No domestic, pen reared, or frozen animals - scrutineers reserve the right to reject any suspect animal.
- 10. All animals to remain on display until after Prize giving Sunday.
- 11. Animal ownership remains the hunter's responsibility - and removed from car park before 6:00PM.
- 11. Entries must be in the hands of the organisers at the Ashley Hotel by 8:00PM on Thursday 1st June 2023.
- 12. NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED -. NO LATE WEIGH INS ACCEPTED
- 13. All Animals must arrive at the weigh station - ASHLEY HOTEL - between 11:00AM and 2:00PM on Sunday 4th June.
- 14. All participants enter at their own risk. Neither the Club, sponsors, nor organisers shall be responsible or liable for any injuries or misadventures that may occur.
- 15. All entrants go into the draw to win spot prizes, but the entrant must be present to win.
- 16. THE JUDGES' DECISION IS FINAL.
- 17. All prizes to be claimed by entrant
- 18. Car park closes at 6:00PM - FOOD AND REFRESHMENTS AVAILABLE. Courtesy van available.
- 19. NO BYO - IF SEEN OR SUSPECTED, immediate removal and disqualification from the event will occur.
